

Regarding Your Term Paper for (AUN 300) Fall, 2024 – 2025)

Hi Guys,

This is a gentle reminder that your term papers are expected to be due by the End of October (1th September 2024 – 31st October, 20204) to be precise.

Hence, ensure to make your submission before the deadline to avoid any technical hitches. The information below are some of the basic guidelines and structure which your term paper is mandatorily expected to follow.

- i. The APA 7th Edition is expected to be used for citation and referencing of all of the entire paper.
- ii. The paper should at least consist of 5 Sections/Chapters:
 - a. Chapter One (The Introduction)
 - b. Chapter Two (Theoretical / Literature Review)
 - c. Chapter Three (Research Methodology)
 - d. Chapter Four (Analysis of Data and Result Presentation)
 - e. Chapter Five (Summary, Conclusion and Recommendations)
 - f. Appendix and References,

Please see the lecture materials and guide on Research writing and Presentation made available to you by your lecturer on the Canvas Platform/Google Classroom Platform, for the purpose of this Term paper.

- iii. The Volume of the entire paper should not exceed 20 - 30 pages in all (Including the Cover Pages, Reference Pages and the Appendix Section). This will attract **(10.00 Marks)**.
- iv. The font size of the project should not exceed 12 Points, except for the headings or where equations are used or entered in the document. The Times Mew Roman style of writing is the only recommended style for this project.
- v. All front pages of the term paper must necessarily bear the Tile of the Research, The Full Names of the Researcher/Student, The full Names of the Students Departmental Address, including email address and Phone Numbers, and Program of Study.
- vi. All students in this class must necessarily prepare at least a **(10-Page)** PowerPoint presentation of their Term Paper for presentation for **(10 – 15 Minutes)** in class. This shall attract a corresponding **(10.00 Marks)**, one week after the date of the submission of your term paper.
